a. To date, the City has lent \$4,188,239 to fund 106 loans provided to 62 unique borrowers for an average of \$67,552 per borrower. In addition, the City has received 20 requests totaling a potential of \$870,000 in additional new loan funding once underwriting and closing is complete.
