### III. Updates on City's Grant Program

1. To date the City has received 144 grant applications and has provided \$297,000 in funding to 12 grantees for an average of \$24,750 per grant. If all 144 applications were to receive the maximum grant amount of \$33,000, \$4,752,000 in grant funds would be disbursed.

### 2. In terms of demographics:

- i. 12 of these grant recipients are African Americans, 1 was Vietnamese and2 did not report their race.
- ii. 6 of the recipients were female and 6 were male.

1. To date, the City has lent \$2,548,000 to 54 unique borrowers, 20 of whom were repeat borrowers, for an average of \$47,185 per borrower and \$34,432 per loan. In addition, the City has received 9 new loan requests totaling a potential of \$1,300,000 in new loan funding once underwriting is complete, assuming each

borrower receives the new maximum loan amount of \$220,000 (new loan tiers discussed below). Note that the majority of the new loan applicants currently have previous loans outstanding.

2. In terms of demographics, 79.2% percent of these no-interest loan recipients are African Americans and 26.4% were women.

### VI. Update from Cannabis Commission Meeting

At last week's CRC Meeting, the CRC approved the following staff recommendations that will be presented to the City Council in November:

- 1. Extend Equity Applicants' Eligibility to Equity Assistance Program Services Up to Four Years from Initial Equity Verification
- 2. Convert \$1.5 Million in Loans to Equity Applicants to Purchase Properties that Support Multiple Equity Applicants to Forgivable Loans
- 3. Authorize Utilizing Up to \$500k from \$1.5 Million Available in Loans for All Eligible Purposes Towards the Purchasing Property Forgivable Loan Program
