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## Introduction

The City of Oakland has contracted with Kimley-Horn to provide technical assistance for the execution of a thorough park assets inventory and condition assessment. The objective of the project is to categorize the City's parks by size, amenities and facilities and then within those categories of park, first establish baseline acceptable conditions by asset type (i.e. pool, restroom, ballfield, pathway) and second, to provide recommendations for maintenance services necessary to restore park assets to fully operational status as measured against baseline conditions established. This inventory and assessment will serve as a critical step in the project, which will ultimately become a guide for strategic decision-making for both Oakland Parks. Recreation, and Youth Development Department (OPRYD) and Oakland Public Works (OPW). The goal of the project is to enhance the overall functionality and quality of the City's park infrastructure.

# Scope of Work

Through the evaluation of data provided by the City including, but not limited to, existing inventory and mapping data, existing maintenance service levels. 2021 Mini Parks Assessment Report, The Open Space, Conservation and Recreation (OSCAR) Element of the City's General Plan and the City's FY23-25 Capital Improvement Plan. Kimley-Horn was able to establish a preliminary inventory of the City's Parks and Recreation System. After development of the preliminary inventory, Kimley-Horn conducted site visits in February and March 2025 to ground truth the quantities of amenities, while also visually assessing the quality, condition, and overall functionality of the built environment of the parks system. Major deferred maintenance items and general accessibility of amenities and facilities were also examined and noted. The following report details the key findings of this component of the project.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

Kimley-Horn did not include detailed assessments of green infrastructure elements such as trees and planting areas. Any scoring or assessment of the quality of these areas was performed by staff. Irrigation systems did not appear to be turned on during the time of on-site assessments and were only visually inspected, when possible.



# **Findings**

#### Condition

Overall, the parks and facilities visited were found to be in average to below-average condition. Most parks visited were observed to contain amenities which had far exceeded their lifecycle due to age and use. Parks and amenities are significantly older and in need of refurbishment and/or replacement. While most existing parks were not noted as posing an immediate safety hazard, there are several amenities that are damaged and in need of replacement.

#### Maintenance

As noted above, most amenities have exceeded their lifecycle, however, the City appears to have made upkeep and maintenance a priority, as most amenities remain functional and do not pose major safety hazards. Instances of graffiti and vandalism appear to be widespread, and several occurrences were noted.

#### **ADA Compliance**

It is advisable for the city to conduct a comprehensive Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance review. This effort would involve inspecting existing facilities, performing self-evaluations, and updating the transition plan as necessary to adhere to ADA standards and regulations for accessible parks and facilities. Although a thorough ADA compliance review wasn't included in this assessment, on-site investigations revealed potential areas for attention, particularly in parking lots, sidewalks, and playground surfacing, emphasizing the importance of ensuring safety commitments.

#### **Facilities**

A facility condition assessment for structures, such as community centers and restroom buildings, was not undertaken as a part of this project. Facilities were only visually inspected. It is recommended that the City undertakes a condition assessment for each of its facilities. The assessment should determine condition, average remaining useful life expectancy, code violations, reason for deficiencies, and effect on structure or occupancy with required maintenance and repair works. Additionally, calculation of the costs for each deficient condition utilizing nationally recognized estimating standards should be included.

#### **Irrigation Systems**

As a part of these on-site assessments, irrigation systems did not appear to be turned on and therefore were only visually inspected. It is recommended that the City undertakes a system-wide irrigation audit to fully inventory and assess the existing irrigation systems and maintenance practices at all its parks and facilities. The audit should evaluate the existing equipment, available supply and demand, hydraulic analysis, and prioritize recommendations and costs for necessary improvements. Identifying deficiencies in the irrigation systems and fixing them will help lead to consistent, quality turf and open space areas that will in turn strengthen the number of programming opportunities.

#### **Mature Trees**

Trees within most parks are large, mature and provide great shade. While these trees are a great asset due to their size and aesthetic appeal, some appear to be declining in health due to age and other environmental factors. Removing all mature trees at one time would be devastating to the character of several facilities and should be avoided when possible. It is recommended that the City undergo a tree lifecycle analysis to understand the impacts the trees' ages may have on future maintenance.

#### Standardized Equipment, Site Furnishings and Branding

It was noted that existing amenities within parks differ significantly and appear to have been replaced on an as-needed basis. Standardizing equipment can ensure safety and reliability, as it adheres to established safety guidelines and regulations, and therefore reducing the risk of injuries. Consistency in equipment design and maintenance facilitates eases inspections and repairs, and promotes cost efficiencies which contributes to the longevity and functionality of park amenities. It appears that the City has begun to focus on a strategic implementation plan to standardize its site furnishings; examples include new trash receptacles, picnic tables and signage. The City should continue to expand its efforts in bringing consistency to its furnishings system-wide.

#### Meaningful Shade

Shade in parks provides a cool and comfortable environment for visitors, offering relief from the sun, which can be particularly intense during the summer months. It was noted during the on-site assessments that several parks lack meaningful shade at selected amenities, such as playgrounds, picnic tables and barbeque grills. By adding additional shade, the City can increase usability and enhance the recreational, social, and environmental value of its parks.

#### **Parking Lots**

Most asphalt and concrete paved parking lots in the City's parks are showing signs of cracking due to age. It is recommended that the City seal coat all surface cracks, at the most, every three years for ease of maintenance and to increase the surface's life expectancy. In most cases, the existing parking lot pavement and subbase have significant life remaining before replacement will be required.

#### **Homeless Encampments**

As a part of the on-site assessments, homeless encampments were noted in approximately 20% of the City's parks. In several cases, the usability of park amenities was comprised.

# **Inventory & Classification Summary**

#### Classifications

#### Mini Parks

A mini park is a small outdoor space, usually less than 1 acre, and most often located in an urban or residential area surrounded by commercial buildings or homes. Mini parks, sometimes called pocket parks, are small spaces that may serve a variety of functions, such as small event spaces, play areas for children, spaces for relaxing and socializing, taking lunch breaks, etc. Successful mini parks have four key qualities: they are accessible, allow people to engage in activities, are comfortable and inviting, and are sociable places. In general, mini parks offer minimal amenities on-site and are not designed to support programmed activities. The service area for mini parks is usually less than a ¼ mile and is intended for users within close walking distance.

The City has 24 mini parks, totaling 8.53 acres.

#### Neighborhood Parks

Neighborhood parks are typically 1½ to 10 acres; however, some are determined by use and facilities offered, not by size alone. The service radius for a neighborhood park is typically ½ mile.

Neighborhood parks should have safe pedestrian access for surrounding residents; parking is typically not provided, but if included accounts for less than ten cars and provides for ADA access. Neighborhood parks serve as a recreational and social focus of the adjoining neighborhoods and contribute to a distinct neighborhood identity.

The City has 46 neighborhood parks, totaling 126.40 acres.

#### Community Parks

Community parks are intended to be accessible to multiple neighborhoods and should focus on meeting community-based recreational needs, as well as preserving unique landscapes and open spaces. Community parks are generally larger in scale than neighborhood parks, but smaller than regional parks, and are designed typically for residents who live within a three-mile radius. When possible, the park may be developed adjacent to a school.

Community parks provide recreational opportunities for the entire family and often contain facilities for specific recreational purposes, such as athletic fields, tennis courts, extreme sports amenities, loop trails, picnic areas, reservable picnic shelters, sports courts, restrooms with drinking fountains, large turfed and landscaped areas, and a playground or spray ground.

Passive outdoor recreation activities such as meditation, quiet reflection, and wildlife watching also take place at community parks.

The City has 19 community parks, totaling 624.22 acres.

#### Athletic Fields

Athletic Fields are typically developed as a part of a larger sports complex with multiple fields, but can also be standalone facilities that are shared with other users, such as schools. Athletic fields can be single-focused or multi-focused and can serve the needs of both youth and adults. Fields should be lighted where possible to maximize the value and productivity of the complex. Sport field design includes appropriate field distances for each sport's governing body and support amenities designed to produce revenue to offset operational costs. Larger signature sports complexes may include enhanced amenities, such as artificial turf, multipurpose field benches and bleachers, scoreboards, amplified sound, scorer's booths, etc.

The City has 13 athletic fields, totaling 63.05 acres.

#### Plazas

A plaza is a public square or open space in a city or town, often used for gatherings, events, or as a pedestrian-friendly area. A plaza is a paved public space designed for people to gather, walk, sit, and congregate. Plazas are often located in the heart of a town or city. Plazas may feature walkways, trees, benches, and fountains, and are sometimes adjacent to shops and restaurants. While a plaza can include trees or other landscaping, it's primarily a paved, open space designed for people to interact with and enjoy the city environment, whereas parks are typically more focused on nature, recreation, and passive leisure activities.

The City has 6 plazas, totaling 1.57 acres.

#### Recreation Conservation Area

Recreation conservation areas are undeveloped but may include natural or paved trails. They contain natural resources that can be managed for recreation and hold natural resource conservation values, such as a desire to protect wildlife habitats, improve water quality, and protect endangered species. Also, recreation conservation areas can provide opportunities for nature-based, unstructured, low-impact recreational opportunities, such as walking and nature viewing.

The City has 12 recreation conservation areas, totaling 1153.05 acres. Note that recreation conservation areas were not assessed as a part of this project.

#### Special Use Parks

Special use parks are areas that include specialized recreational activities. This classification covers a broad range of parks and recreation facilities oriented toward a single-purpose use. They often fall into three general categories:

- Cultural Facilities unique resources offering historical, educational, visual/performance art or other similar experiences. These include museums, theaters, galleries, libraries and other civic sites.
- 2) Indoor Facilities geared toward indoor uses, such as gymnasiums, community centers, teen/senior centers, aquatic centers, ice arenas, etc.
- 3) Unique Sites generally a single use, but smaller than a regional park and not necessarily of a significance that might draw from a larger regional base. These may include arboretums, cemeteries, plazas, sports stadiums


The City has 13 special use parks, totaling 137.13 acres.

#### Linear Parks

Linear parks and trails are recognized for their ability to connect people and places while serving as active transportation facilities. Linking neighborhoods, parks, recreation facilities, attractions, and natural areas with a multi-use trail fulfills three guiding principles simultaneously:

- 1) Protect natural areas along river and open space areas
- 2) Provide people with a way to access and enjoy them
- 3) Provide a safe alternative form of active transportation

The City has 8 linear parks, totaling 42.29 acres.

# **Evaluation Methodology**

The quality of each asset within the overall City system is an important factor when evaluating the current level of service provided. Parks that are poorly maintained, have outdated infrastructure, or fail to offer a high-quality user experience are unlikely to attract visitors. By examining how each park compares to one another, department management and staff can evaluate and prioritize park improvement projects and identify gaps in coverage across the entire City system.

The quality of each asset was assessed as a part of the on-site review and inventory. The following factors were the primary categories reviewed during the inventory phase:

- Asset Age
- Asset Size
- Asset Condition



For each asset, a grading standard has been assigned to the observed amenities within it. These scores are qualitative in nature and are determined based on the observations of the personnel conducting the field inventory. These categories were evaluated based on the individual asset's condition as opposed to the overall system during the inventory. If the amenity and/or facility was noted to exist in a condition well below that of similar equipment within other parks, then it was noted within the matrix as such. The number values were then used to provide a numerical score for the park based on the number of opportunities and quality of opportunities offered.

The following scoring system was used:

#### Grading Standard F / Priority 1 - Currently Critical

Conditions in this category require immediate action by the end of the current fiscal year to:

- · Correct a safety hazard
- Stop accelerated deterioration
- Return a facility/system to operational status

#### Grading Standard D / Priority 2 - Potentially Critical

Conditions in this category, if not corrected expeditiously, will become critical soon. Situations within this category include:

- · Correct a safety hazard
- Stop accelerated deterioration
- Return a facility/system to operational status

#### Grading Standard C / Priority 3 - Necessary, But Not Yet Critical

Conditions in this category require appropriate attention to preclude predictable deterioration and associated damage or higher costs if deferred further.

#### Grading Standard B / Priority 4 - Recommended

Conditions in this category include items that represent a sensible improvement to existing conditions, include finishes that have deteriorated, and are required to maintain the required aesthetic standards. These are not required for the most basic functioning of the facility.

### Grading Standard A / Priority 5 - Early in Lifecycle

Conditions in this category function properly and are early enough in their lifecycle that improvements are not currently needed.







#### Note:







## Park Condition by Council District (Average)








## Park Acreage by Equity Priority Area

## Systemwide Average Amenity Condition








Parks with Homeless Encampments (Full System)




Homeless Encampments by Planning Area


