- A. Roll Call and Determination of Quorum
Chair Smith, Vice Chair Walker, Commissioners Sage, Harvey, Pademore and Grant and City Administrator staff present
- B. Approval of the Draft Minutes from the CRC Meeting on August 7, 2025
VC Walker made motion to approve August draft minutes, seconded by Harvey. Passes with 4 ayes and one abstained Chair Smith.
- C. Reports for Discussion and Possible Action
1. Update on CRC’s Annual Report to the City Council - *Commissioners gave an update on the progress of the report. Draft would be shared by the Commission to City Administrator staff for review and submission to Council when complete.*
 2. Special Meetings & Subcommittee Status – *Commissioners discussed the relevance of forming subcommittees to discuss specific topics monthly and bring those items to the regular scheduled CRC meeting which has been suggested to be moved to a quarterly format to ensure a robust agenda and that actionable items have been mapped out for the Commissions consideration.*
 3. Go Biz 6 Grant Suggestions from Commissioners – *City Administrator staff requested the Commission share any suggestions for how to spend Go Biz 6 grant funds.*
 4. Update on Shared Kitchens – *City Administrator staff updated the Commission on Oakland Equity Collective and Women of Excellence status.*
 5. Equity Operators Involvement in the Public Awareness Campaign – *Dale Sky of Oaksterdam gave an update and answered questions from the Commission.*
 6. Implementation Update on State Grants – *City Administrator staff gave update on state grants.*
 7. Follow up on Graphs which identify no address- *Staff informed Commission that the City is able to accept applications for cannabis businesses without an identifiable address. Before the business is issued a permit, they must identify a location for their business.*

- *Discussion to possibly place a requirement on general dispensaries to carry equity products*
- E. Open Forum / Public Comment – *The commission chose to vote on a land a labor acknowledgement to begin meetings, motion made by Member Padmore second by Chair Smith, passes with 4 ayes and one abstaining Member Grant. Chair Smith made motion to ask OEC to attend the CRC on a future date, second Member Padmore motion passes unanimously. Member Sage made a motion to set parameters to keep equity businesses safer from exploitation seconded by Chair Smith passes unanimously. Public made a comment on open seat on the CRC. City staff stated will check on status with the mayor’s office. Member Padmore resigned from the CRC effective immediately due to conflicts and ending present term. Chair*

Smooth resigned from Chair and membership of the CRC effective immediately due to need for prioritization of matters outside of the Commission.

ITEM C (1) Nominations and vote on new Chair and Vice Chair

Chair Smith has resigned from the CRC Effective September 4, 2025. Commissioners will vote on a new Chair and possibly Vice Chair.

Commissioners will discuss and vote on frequency of regular CRC meetings.

ITEM C (4) Discussion on what is required to establish a standalone City department for the administration and regulation of cannabis businesses.

The City Attorney has given advice on what it would take to establish a Department of Cannabis in the City of Oakland, staff will share their advice.

ITEM C (5) Discuss and vote to request a Brown Act Training /Q&A session with the City Attorney

Considering the recent Oaklandside article depicting Brown Act violations by Council members and City staff, the City Attorney's office will offer a Brown Act training and Q&A session with the commission if so desired by this body.

ITEM C (6) Implementation Update on State Grants

Oakland's pioneering race and equity analysis of the cannabis industry and creation of an Equity Program inspired jurisdictions across the country to pursue and support similar programs. Then starting in 2019 the State of California set aside annual grant funding to support local jurisdictions' cannabis equity programs. **Table A** outlines the amount of funding the City has received from the State of California for its Equity Program, Oakland's ranking among local jurisdictions each year, and the total amount of funding set aside by the State of California that year.

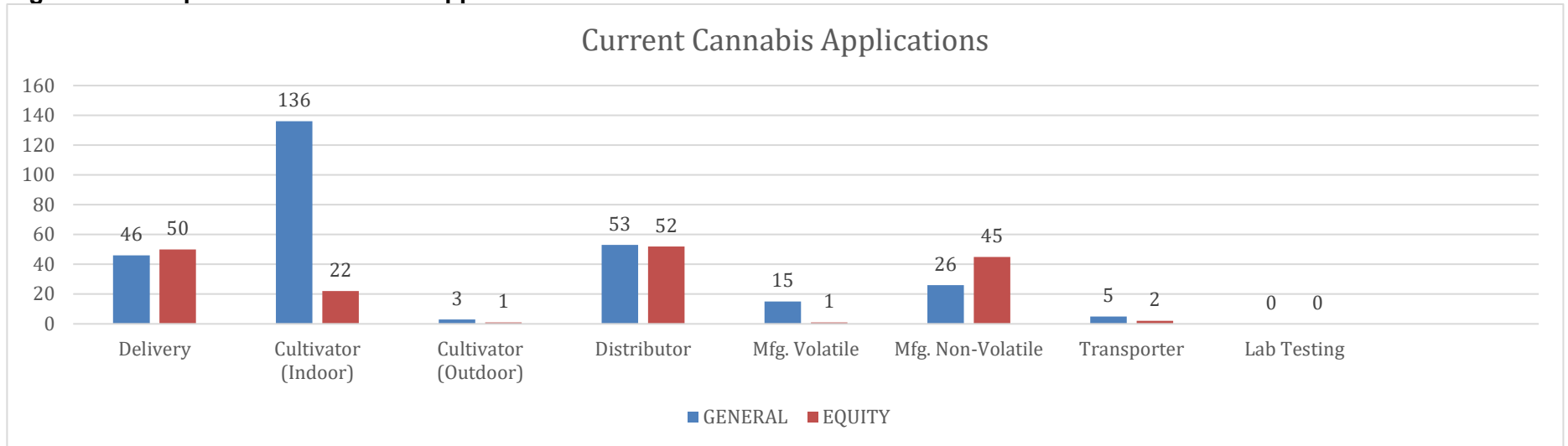

Figure F-4 Conditional Operating and Non-Operating Permits

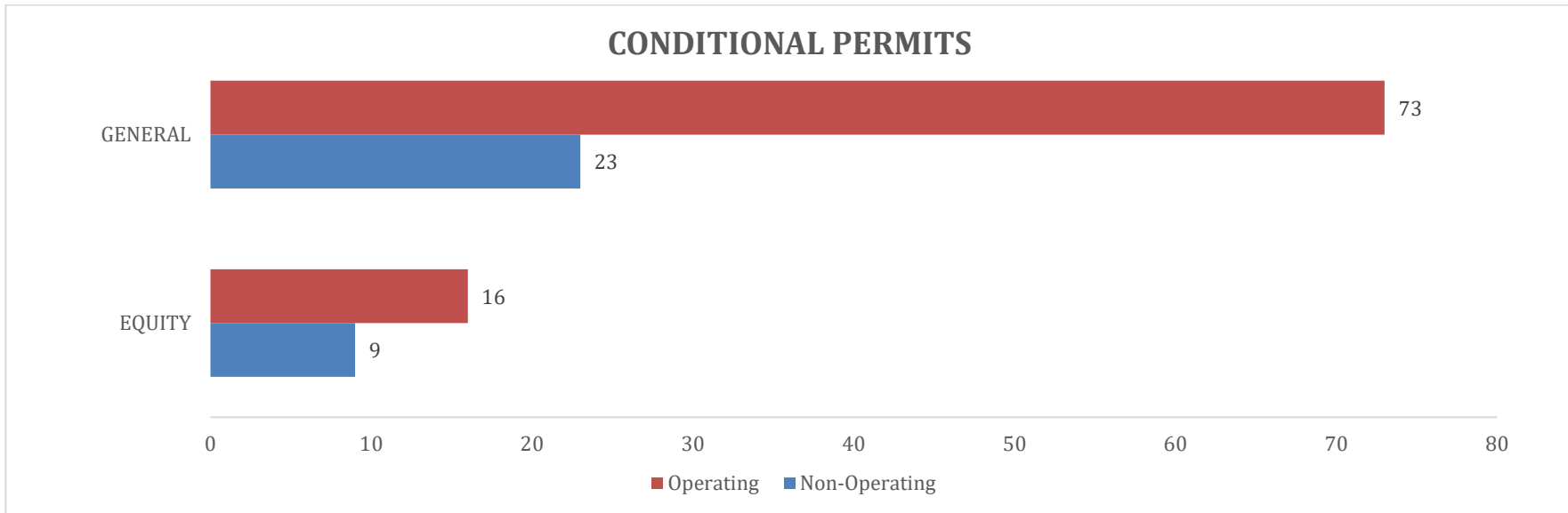


Figure F-5: Operators Issued Annual State Licenses

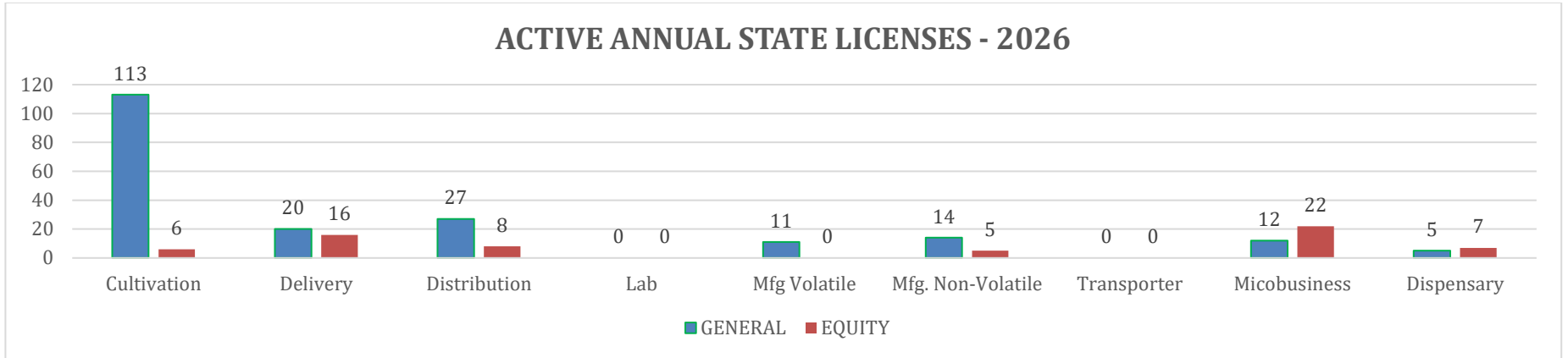


Figure F-6: Initial Annual Permits Issued (2025-2026)

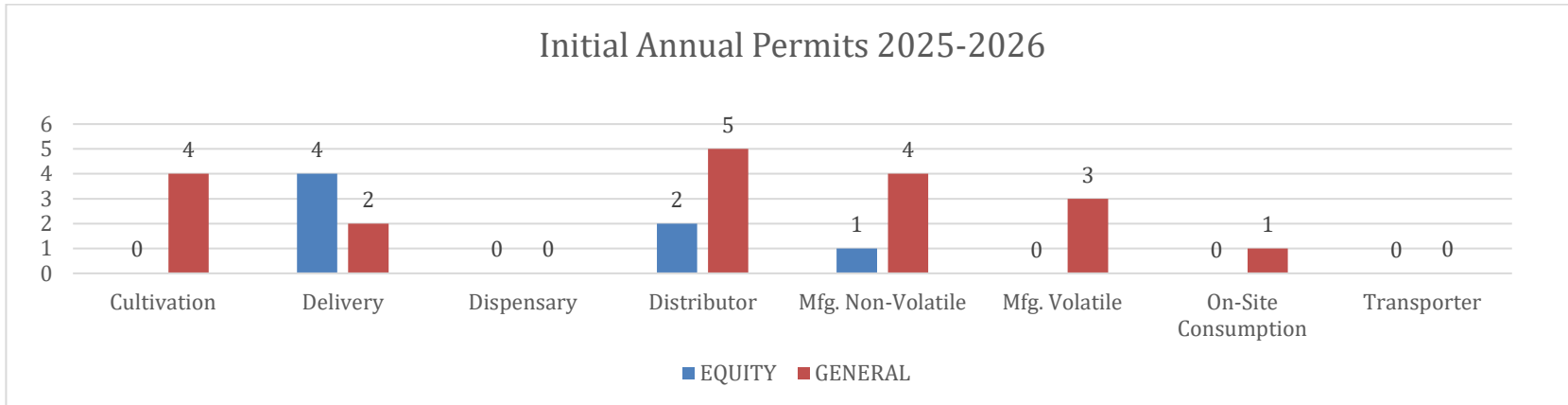


Figure F-7: Renewal Annual Permits Issued (2025-2026)
