## Planning Commission Questions, Comments and Concerns:

Commissioner Moore stated that he is familiar with the telecom coverage in the Oakland Hills area and this project proposal seems to be a wise solution so far.

Commissioner Coleman concurred with Commissioner Moore's comments.

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Vice Chair Pattillo asked if the first option in the plan was more slender and less boxy looking than this plan before us tonight, because that is what's shown in the picture included in the staff report. Could the two antennas be mounted onto the pole to provide a more slender look?

Mr. Yergovich responded to Vice Chair Pattillo's inquiry by stating that there are no alternatives to mount the antennas onto the pole in order to provide a slender look.

Commissioner Coleman reiterated the need for maps of the telecom pole locations in the City of Oakland that he has requested at previous Planning Commission meetings. Is it really true that there are no alternatives or is there an antenna at another location that could provide a more slender look?

Mr. Yergovich responded to Commissioner Coleman's inquiry, stating that they are unable to utilize other telecom facilities that are not owned by AT&T, therefore, there are no alternatives.

Chair Huntsman feels that the current project proposal is a compromise that is amenable.

Commissioner Whales made a motion to approve, seconded by Commissioner Coleman.
