
## Designated Barbecue Locations Lakeside Park & Pine Knoll Park

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission approved barbecue locations at Lakeside Park and Pine Knoll Park during their July 2015 meeting. There are two types of grilling now allowed:

Charcoal Grilling: Allowed in designated areas only.

Stationary Charcoal Pit

## Non-Charcoal Portable Grilling: Allowed in designated areas only.

Non-Charcoal Portable Grill

Patrons may bring their own non-charcoal portable grill, not to exceed 27 inches in width Please note: Charcoal grills are not allowed in designated portable grilling areas.

Large groups are encouraged to utilize the Bandstand and Lake Merritt Boating Center picnic sites that include stationary charcoal barbecue pits and picnic tables. Please see map and below grid for locations, portable grill restrictions, and hours.

Linear park on the east side of Lake Merritt from Boden Way to Pine Knoll Park	Portable non-charcoal grills only Grill size: Not to exceed 27 inches in width	8:00 a.m. to 3 p.m.
Pine Knoll Park (Lakeshore Avenue at Hanover Avenue)	Portable non-charcoal grills only Grill size: Not to exceed 27 inches in width	8:00 a.m. to 3 p.m.
