

A Brief Overview

Nestled at the base of Oakland's Southern foothills, the Oak Knoll planned community is the culmination of a collaborative effort on the part of the City of Oakland, residents and renowned California developer SunCal to reinvigorate and revitalize one of the most significant properties in the Bay Area.

Located on site of the former Oak Knoll Naval Hospital, Oak Knoll will be a pedestrian friendly plan and designed oriented around the restored creek for a highly livable community.

For 54 years the Oak Knoll Naval Hospital treated American servicemen including those wounded during WWII, the Korean War and Vietnam. It was closed in 1996 and sat vacant for another 16 years during which the site and its buildings were vandalized and left in extreme disrepair.

SunCal is excited to be a part of the transformation of this unique property and honoring the history of this important place in the planning. We look forward to continuing the dialogue we began in 2006, reacquainting with the neighbors and meeting with community members interested in learning about the Oak Knoll development.
