Notify the board member 90 days prior to term expiration
Have a discussion at the Executive Committee regarding the Private Sector
Recommendations. In some cases, the board members will continue with the same
Private Sector Agency. If this is the case, prepare letter to send to the director of the
agency. See sample letter. If a motion occurs at the executive committee meeting, the
motion would have to be ratified at the full Administering Board meeting.

OR

• If the Executive Committee decides to have representation from another agency, send letters to all the agencies on the Administrative Board Private Sector Recommendations list. Make sure list is current with the contact and address information. Once letters are received from any interested agencies, a discussion should be held at the Executive Committee meeting and if a motion occurs it would be ratified at the full Administering Board meeting.

If the board wishes to have other agency representation, any letters of interest received will be discussed, contacted, and interviewed. (see AC-OCAP Private Sector Board Selection Criteria and AC-OCAP By-laws – Article IV, Administering Board Membership).
