GUIDELINES FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TEMPORARY PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY CANOPY

GENERAL NOTES:

- I. STREET OBSTRUCTION PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL TEMPORARY WALKWAY IN PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY.
- 2. THE TEMPORARY WALKWAY SHALL CONFORM TO THE GENERAL GUIDELINES AND DETAILS SET FORTH IN THESE DRAWINGS (M-4 & M-5). THE WALKWAY MUST CONFORM TO ALL REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 44 "PROTECTION OF PEDESTRIANS DURING CONSTRUCTION OR DEMOLITION" OF THE CURRENTLY ADOPTED UNIFORM BUILDING CODE (UBC).
- 3. LOCATION PLANS SHOWING ALL EXISTING FACILITIES IN RELATIONSHIP TO THE PROPOSED WALKWAY AND WITHIN 50' OF EACH END OF WALKWAY SHALL BE SUBMITTED WITH ALL PERMIT APPLICATIONS.
- 4. VISIBILITY OF SIGNS AND ADJACENT DRIVEWAYS OR INTERSECTIONS SHALL BE MAINTAINED, WARNING SIGNS MAY BE REQUIRED.
- 5, ACCESS TO FIRE HYDRANTS, UTILITY METERS AND POLES, ETC. SHALL BE MAINTAINED. ACCESS TO FIRE HYDRANT SHALL BE MAINTAINED BY MODIFYING THE BUILDING SIDE WALKWAY WALL TO ALLOW FOR 3 FEET CLEAR ACCESS AREA TO HYDRANT. HYDRANT ACCESS DETAILS MUST BE APPROVED BY FIRE MARSHALL.
- 6. DRAINAGE SHALL BE MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE TEMPORARY WALKWAY AREAS.
- 7. TWO (2) SELF-POWERED FLASHERS SHALL BE INSTALLED AT EACH END OF WALKWAY AND REFLECTORS AT 20' INTERVALS ALONG LENGTH.
- 8. ALL WALLS AND STUDS VISIBLE TO THE PUBLIC SHALL BE PAINTED WITH WHITE EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT.
- 9. ALL CHANGES IN GRADE (RAMPING) BETWEEN THE TEMPORARY WALKWAY AND OTHER EXISTING FACILITIES SHALL NOT EXCEED 1:12 SLOPE. RAMPS SHALL BE STRUCTURALLY SOUND, SAFE AND FREE OF ANY POTENTIAL TRIPPING HAZARD.
- 10. NAILING SCHEDULE SHALL CONFORM TO TABLE 23-II-B-I OF THE 1997 UBC. PLYWOOD SPLICE PLATES SHALL BE NAILED @ 6" MAX 0.C.
- II. LUMBER SHALL BE DOUGLAS FIR CONSTRUCTION OR BETTER.
- 12. PLYWOOD SHALL BE C-D EXTERIOR TYPE OR BETTER.
