


Project is located on 2nd Street between Clay Street and Alice Street


- Transit hub (Clay Street to Washington Street)
- Bike lane connection (Harrison Street to Alice Street)




Existing Conditions

- Sidewalk is not ADA compliant
- No shelter or seating
- Poor lighting
- Pavement is deforming







Project Scope

- Establishing a transit hub at an existing bus stop by providing real-time transit information, seating, and shelter
- Improving lighting, sidewalk, pedestrian crossings, and wayfinding at and between transit stations
- Relocating a bikeshare station to be near the transit hub to support convenient transit connections
- Connecting an existing bike lane across a one block gap and reconfiguring parking
- Making upgrades to improve bus operations, such as concrete bus pads and layover facility improvements for bus drivers
- Rerouting Line 12 in coordination with the Embarcadero West Rail Safety and Access Improvements
