




Calm East Oakland Streets

The goal of this project is to create safe inviting streets for people to walk or bike to neighborhood destinations such as schools, libraries, recreation centers, parks, and corner stores. The project aims to fix broken streets and sidewalks and increase residential street safety by slowing vehicle speeds and decreasing cut-through traffic.

What kind of improvements create a calm street?

To keep streets slower, calmer and more comfortable for people walking and biking improvements may include:



Speed humps, traffic circles, and wider sidewalks at crosswalks to slow down motorists



Repaving streets and fixing drainage problems to make bicycling safer and more comfortable



Limited vehicle access zones to reduce cut-through traffic on residential streets



Crossing improvements to help people cross major streets like Bancroft Ave and International Blvd.
