

## Schedule

**Spring 2026: Outreach & Conceptual Design**

**Late 2026: Final Design**

**2028: Construction**

# Project Goal

Create a low-stress walking and biking connection between Fruitvale BART/East Bay Greenway and the neighborhoods to the north

The City will achieve this goal by:

- Slowing vehicles through extensive traffic calming
- Making people walking easier to see

# 38th Ave Traffic Calming = Paving Project

Paving Projects allow the City to quickly install safety improvements.

38th Avenue is on Oakland's 5-Year Paving Plan, funded by 2022 Measure U Affordable Housing Infrastructure Bond

Measure U instructs the City to:

**“Implement City of Oakland pedestrian and bicycle safety plans wherever and whenever street repaving and reconstruction is performed”**



Final designs dependent on community feedback, engineering study, Fire Dept requirements







Exploring a crosswalk and stop sign/ flashing beacon






