Switching Forms


To record violence interruption activities that occur <u>before October 1</u>, <u>2025</u>, use the below forms:

- CBO violence interruption response
- Shooting and homicide response

To record violence interruption activities on or after October 1, 2025, use the **Violence Interruption Form** and link to relevant incidents.



Step 1: Select "Violence Interruption" on the left side of the screen and then select "+ New Violence Intervention Form" on the right side.






Step 2: Complete the form by entering details such as VI type, agency name, type of activity, date, etc.






Step 3: Locate the incident in the list that appears. You can do this by clicking on the date header twice to sort it by most recently entered.





Step 3: You can also find the incident by clicking "Add Search Field" and searching for the incident by address or name. Enter "%" first.





Step 3: After selecting an incident to link, the incident will appear on the **Violence Interruption Form**.




Creating a School Conflict Form

Step 1: Select the link that appears on the Violence Intervention Form when "School VI" is selected.

OR select "School Conflict" on the left side of the screen under "Search Records."


Click <u>HERE</u> to create a new School Conflict record. Link will open in a new tab.

Making a Referral

To make a referral for life coaching, use this link to complete a referral form.





Completing Eligibility Screener

The referral link will require you to complete an eligibility screener to determine whether someone is eligible for life coaching services. You do not need to ask these questions directly but can gather the information through general conversation or prior knowledge. Individuals must meet 2 of the criteria to be eligible for DVP-funded services.

Please complete the below screener to determine if this individual is eligible. If they are eligible, a box will pop up that says so.
Eligibility Screener (must meet 2 of 4)*
✓ Is the individual connected to a street crew or group?
✓ Has the individual ever been intentionally shot, stabbed, or shot at?
Does the individual have a history with the criminal or juvenile justice system?
In the past six months, has a close friend or family member of the individual been shot or arrested for a shooting?
This individual is eligible for DVP life coaching services.
